

1. General description

Planar passivated high commutation three quadrant triac in a SOT186A (TO-220F) "full pack" plastic package intended for use in circuits where high static and dynamic dV/dt and high dI/dt can occur. This "series B" triac will commutate the full rated RMS current at the maximum rated junction temperature without the aid of a snubber.

2. Features and benefits

- 3Q technology for improved noise immunity
- High commutation capability with maximum false trigger immunity
- High voltage capability
- Isolated mounting base package
- Less sensitive gate for highest noise immunity
- Planar passivated for voltage ruggedness and reliability
- Triggering in three quadrants only
- Very high immunity to false turn-on by dV/dt

- Electronic thermostats (heating and cooling)
- High power motor controls e.g. washing machines and vacuum cleaners
- Rectifier-fed DC inductive loads e.g. DC motors and solenoids

Fig. 1. RMS on-state current as a function of heatsink temperature; maximum values



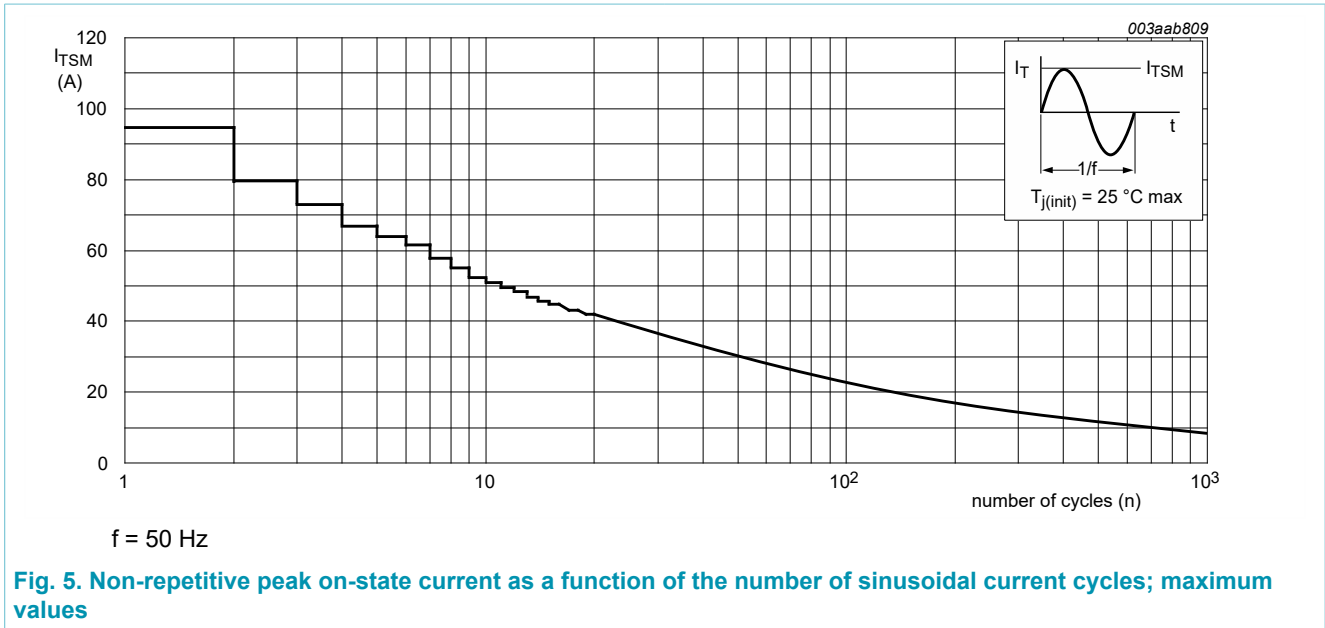
Fig. 2. RMS on-state current as a function of surge duration; maximum values

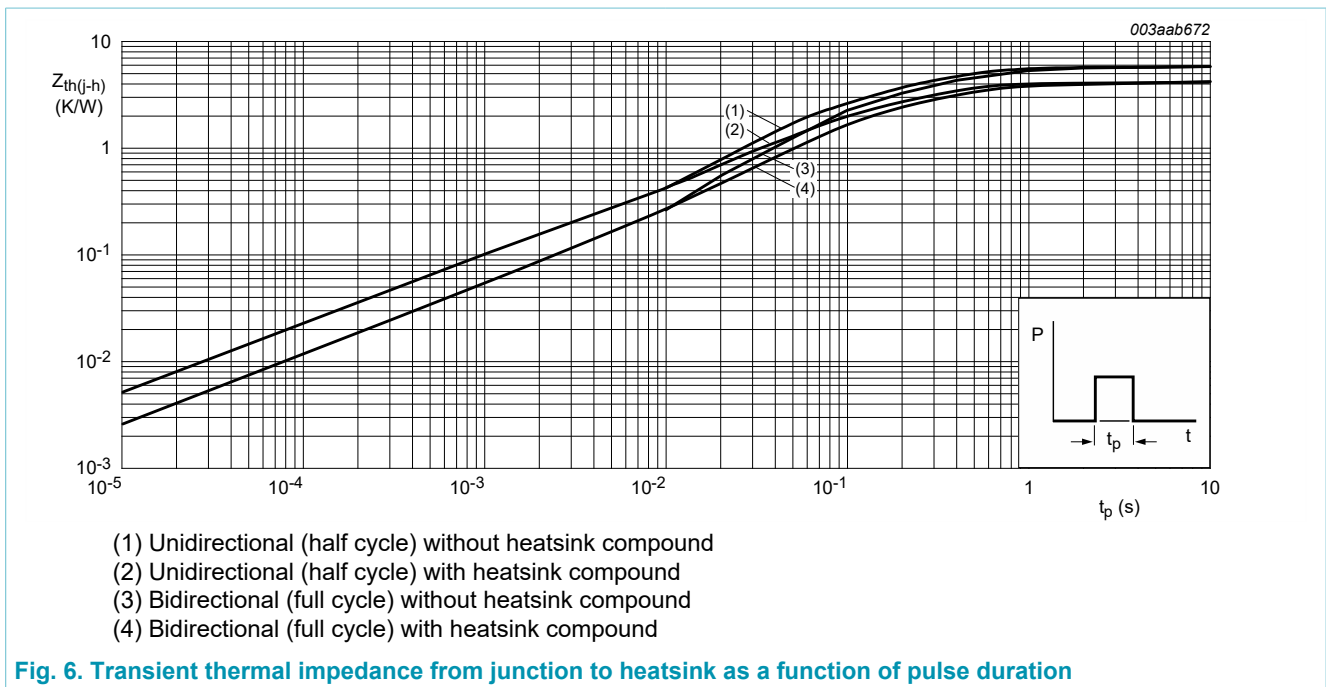


Fig. 6. Transient thermal impedance from junction to heatsink as a function of pulse duration

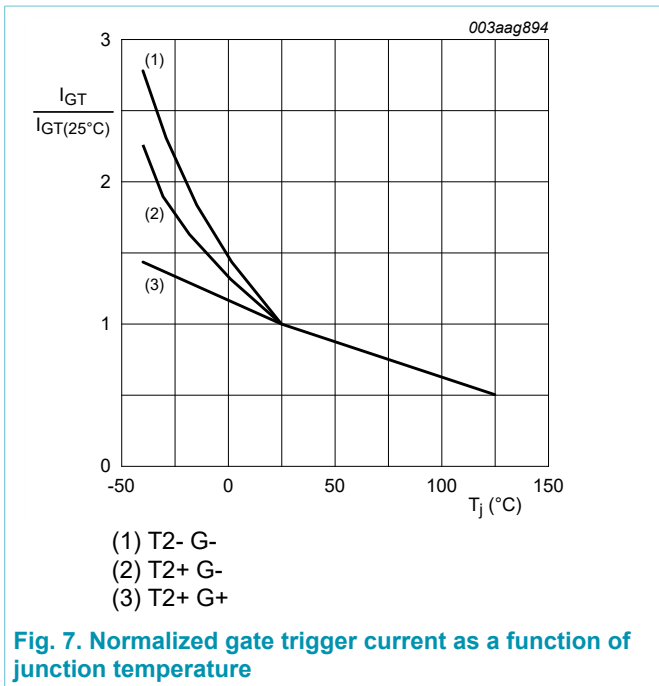


Fig. 7. Normalized gate trigger current as a function of junction temperature

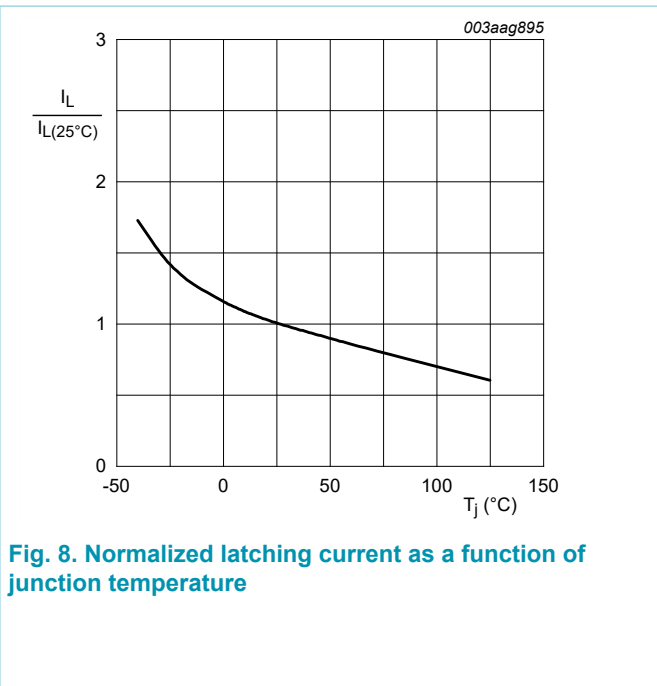


Fig. 8. Normalized latching current as a function of junction temperature
